Doxey Hub

Shed Project - Thanks to funding from The People's Health Trust, Konnektiv Arts are working with Doxey residents to bring a disused lock up and yard back into use for the community. A gate is to be put between the Hub Garden and lockup to make the lockup accessible to groups and families using the Hub. The idea is for the shed to be used as a workshop for activities such as bicycle maintenance, gardening and carpentry. Ideas and input from the community members are being actively sought.
