What Is Being Proposed.

"To create a new town council for the unparished area of Stafford to include the parishad area of Doxey."

At present, Doxey has its own elected Parish Council, focused entirely on representing the needs, concerns and priorities of this community.

Under the proposals being considered, Doxey would no longer have its own parish council and would instead be represented by councillors on a single Stafford Town Council, covering the whole of Stafford.

Doxey Parish Council believes it is important that residents understand what this could mean and why we are opposed to the loss of Doxey Parish Council.

Why Doxey Parish Council is against the proposal of including Doxey.

Doxey Parish Council has serious concerns about the impact this change could have on local representation.

In particular, we believe residents could lose:

- Local representation by elected councillors that serve only Doxey Village.
- Loss of community events such as Doxey Village Day, Over 65's Xmas meal
- Loss of regular maintenance for Castle View Park
- You could also see a potential increase in your contribution from your council tax. Doxey Parish Council's precept is spent on the village of Doxey, if Doxey Parish Council is merged into the new Town Council you're portion of the precept would almost certainly increase and not be spent on Doxey Village. An average town council precept is £350k Doxey Parish Council's precept is £24,950.

For these reasons, Doxey Parish Council believes that local decision-making should remain as close to residents as possible, and that Doxey Village is best served by retaining its own parish council.
