The partnership, are now waiting for Clarion Housing to set up a contract and give a start date so they can open up the Hub again and start to run activities there.

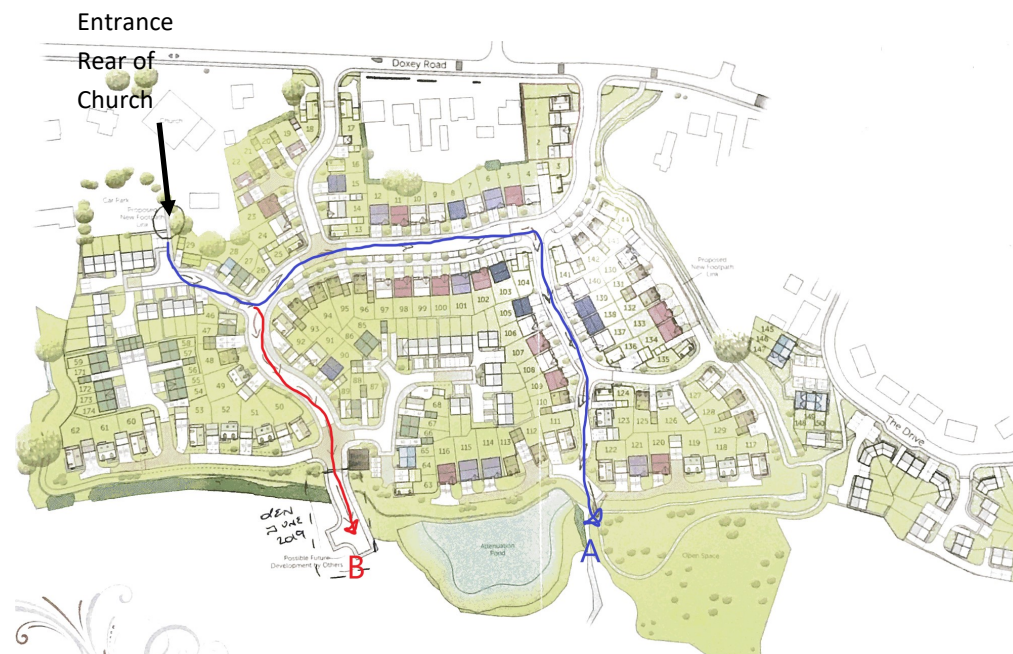
They are very keen to see the use of the Hub guided by Doxey residents and so look forward to hearing from anyone living in Doxey who has ideas about how it could be used.

The Parish council have spoken to Bellway who have assisted us with a map to show where the new pathways will go. Route A is the current route until the site is completed in approx. June 2019 and the site compound removed when route B will become the final route.

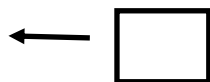
We are asking people to comment on the proposals by choosing 3 pieces of equipment they would like to see included on the park.
