Castle View Park—Updated signage

Many residents will have seen the updated signage at each entrance and exit to the park. This updates the notice in the noticeboard which wasn't as easily visible to all.

The Parish Council agreed when they took over the play area to encourage the use of leads for dogs on the park due to the play equipment and the issues that dog mess can cause in these areas. Due to the design of the park the equipment cannot be fenced off to prevent dogs from accessing it.

We also understand that there have been a few individuals who have been shouting at dog owners and making them feel threatened. We would ask all residents to be polite and respectful to each other and in the event that they are unhappy to contact our local PCSO's and police.

Doxey Hub update

The Doxey Hub partnership, consisting of Signposts, Rising Brook Community Church, Doxey Parish Church and The Youth Net are now able to access the building.

However because of a burst pipe occurring on 3rd February some damage has been done to the Fire Alarm system and so heating engineers have not been able to repair the boiler.

Clarion Housing are pulling out all the stops to get it all sorted out, but until it is, the building is effectively unusable. It may be late February before we can use the building again.




